

Attention Middle School Students:

EVENTS & INCENTIVES EXPECTATIONS

In an effort to promote academic excellence and our school expectations, we are sharing the criteria for engaging in social events/incentive activities at Pershing School. All students are expected to follow all school rules and procedures, additionally, students are expected to be Respectful, Responsible, Safe and Kind in all interactions on campus.

Students failing to meet the criteria listed below will not be able to engage in incentive activities, field trips, events, or socials.

- Students earning an F in any course prior to the event (or payment due date). We will first review Progress Reports/Report Cards (*if no PR or RC has been issued then the most current grade will be used to determine eligibility*). If your grades have improved, we will permit attendance at the events as long as the improvement occurs **prior** to the deadline for ticket sales, payment or other attendance criteria.
- Students receiving a level 1 or 2 discipline referral in the quarter the event occurs (*Note: students receiving a referral after payment but before the event will not be allowed to attend the event*).
- Students receiving a Level 3 or 4 discipline referral will not be permitted to attend any incentive activity for the remainder of the school year.
- Students receiving more than 3 days of detention in the quarter the event occurs (*excessive detentions will escalate to referrals*).
- Students must be present at school on the day of the event and must be present in all classes (*excused early dismissal for approved reasons are permitted*).
- Only students currently enrolled at Pershing School can attend.
